

Privacy Policy and Use of Cookies

1. What is a cookie?

A cookie is a small data or text file stored on your computer by a website. Different types of cookies exist, for example technical cookies used to provide parameters for the website's language, session cookies (also called temporary cookies) and tracking cookies installed to optimize the website in line with your use.

2. How are these cookies used?

CFL Mobility would like to inform you about the European legislation concerning the cookies we use. The cookies help **CFL Mobility** optimize your visits to our website, storing your choices (for example your choice of language, a newsletter, etc.) and to propose tailored services and offerings. The cookies we use are safe and secure and help us inter alia to identify possible errors. The cookies may record information directly related to you.

When consulting the **CFL Mobility** website, we recommend that you accept the cookies. However, you are free to reject their use.

3. Management of the cookies

The storage of a cookie on your work station is subject to your consent.

Using the parameters in your browser, you can at any time choose to accept or reject the storage of cookies on your work station.

You can configure your browser as you require, either (a) consenting to cookies being accepted and stored on your work station, or (b) rejecting them

1. Consent to cookies

If your browser is configured to accept the storage of cookies on your work station, the cookies belonging to the web pages and contents you have looked at will be systematically stored on your work station.

2. Rejection of cookies

You can configure your browser:

- to accept or reject cookies on an ad hoc basis before they are stored;
- to systematically reject the storage of cookies on your work station.

Please note: The way your browser is configured with regard to the acceptance / rejection of cookies may affect your Internet browsing and your conditions of access to certain websites requiring the use of these cookies.

If you opt to reject the storage of cookies on your work station or if you delete ones that have been stored there, we will not assume any liability for the consequences associated with the lower functional level of our services resulting from the impossibility for us to store or consult the cookies necessary for their proper functioning.
